


■ TCP/IP Settings


- (1) From the “Apple Menu,” open the “Control Panel,” then open the “TCP/IP” window. Enter the items as shown on the right.
- (2) When you have set the items listed above, click on the close box in the upper-left corner of the “TCP/IP” window to save your settings and close the window.



- ① Select “Ethernet” from the “Connect via” selection box.
- ② Select “Using DHCP Server” from the “Configure” selection box.
- ③ Leave a blank in the “DHCP Client ID” field.

■ Checking your IP Address

- (1) From the “Apple Menu,” open the “Control Panel,” then open the “TCP/IP” window. Verify that the settings are as shown on the right.
- (2) When you have set the items listed above, click on the close box in the upper-left corner of the “TCP/IP” window to save your settings and close the window.



- ① Verify that “Ethernet” is selected in the “Connect via” selection box.
- ② Verify that “Using DHCP Server” is selected in the “Configure:” selection box.
- ③ Verify that the “DHCP Client ID” field is blank.
